



## RED Wine:

6 Malbec, Septima, Argentina 9.50  
*Argentina's favourite wine export. Full rich fruit with a firm backbone. You may need a knife and fork for this chewy number!*

## Australia

7 Tyrrell's Pinot Noir, New South Wales 11.20  
*Red cherry and berry fruits dominate. Really subtle but so moreish it hurts, more akin to a French Burgundy than a new world pretender.*

## Chile

8 Maiden Flight Reserva Shiraz, Colchagua Valley 10.30  
*From the famous Cono Sur vineyards comes a classic Shiraz with complex ripe fruits and a punchy finish*  
9 Cousino Macul Merlot, Maipo Valley 9.95  
*This Latin American beauty is supple, plump and lovable with a well rounded smooth chassis*  
10 Los Gansos Pinot Noir 8.50  
*Really elegant, light, beautifully fruity, like drinking Ribena and goes down just as easily*

## France

11 Chateau Lamothe Premieres Cotes De Bordeaux Half Bottle 7.00 Bottle 13.50  
*Classic easy drinking claret from a superb family run Chateau*  
12 Coteaux du Tricastin, Rhone 9.50  
*Really smooth blend, nice and spicy, with a little bit of pepper and a good lasting finish*  
13 Dom Prieure "Les Gollardes" Savigny, Burgundy 18.50  
*A superb Pinot Noir. Sensual, perfumed and luscious with a gradual farmyard and gamey depth*

## Italy

14 Valpolicella DOC, Alpha Zeta - Veneto 8.50  
*From an award winning vineyard. Big red fruit flavours with the added bonus of old vine Sangiovese giving great depth & quality*  
16 Tenuta Argentera "Poggio ai Genepri" DOC Bolgheri – Tuscany 14.50  
*Bolgheri is fast becoming THE place for Cabernet Sauvignon in Italy – and this blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah and Merlot is no exception*  
18 Nero D'Avola, Baglio Curatolo – Sicily 13.50  
*Wow, full on mulberry scented aroma's with a red fruit flavour – you can almost feel the Sicilian heat on this beauty...!*

## Portugal

20 Dom Martinho, Rothschild – Alentejano, Portugal 12.50  
*From the legendary Lafite Rothschild Portuguese Estates this wine is a Tempranillo, Cabernet Sauvignon and Syrah blend, oozing classy fruit with a good complexity*

## South Africa

21 Pinotage, Neil Joubert 8.50  
*South Africa's very own grape varietal. As tough as a Springbok prop forward with a touch of Habana-like elegance!*

## Spain

22 Vina Pomal, Crianza – Rioja 9.50  
*Fresh cherry, leather and vanilla, this is Rioja at it's best – superb with food*  
23 Urbina Garnacha – Rioja 8.75  
*It's a little bit special, 100% Garnacha or Grenache, think raspberries, currants and cherries with a good long finish. From a small family run estate.*  
24 Legaris Crianza – Ribero Del Duero 20.00  
*For the discerning Spanish wine fan comes this robust 'matador' of a wine from a great wine region, simply stunning*



## ROSE Wine:

- 26 Syrah Rose, In Situ, Chile 8.75  
*Full of floral aromas and raspberry flavours with a crisp acidity – organic too!*

## WHITE Wine:

### Australia

- 34 Verdelho, Tyrrell's Old Winery, New South Wales 11.00  
*Fresh, lively, quite a tropical nose and touches of spice, crisp lemony finish...quite a lot to take in but it's by no means an assault*

### Chile

- 35 Los Gansos Gewurtztraminer, Central Valley 8.10  
*Really unusual, fresh fruits a little touch of lychee but very subtle, it's very fresh and very savoury. Have no fear of this wine, try it, we think you'll love it!*

- 36 Cousino Macul Riesling, Maipo Valley 9.85  
*You'll simply love the aromatic scents & grapefruit flavours of this crisp, dry Chilean Riesling*

- 37 In Situ Chardonnay Viognier, Aconcagua Valley 11.20  
*The best bits from each grape, crisp and dry without the traditional oakiness of a Chardonnay, we like this wine!*

### France

- 38 Chablis Domaine le Verger, Alan Geoffroy, Chablis 16.00  
*Classic steely fresh and silky, its chardonnay Jim but not as we know it*

- 39 Chateau Lamothe Blanc de Blancs, Bordeaux Half Bottle 7.00 Bottle 13.00  
*A classic Bordeaux white with lots of fresh fruits and lime on the finish*

- 40 Balland Sancerre, Loire 16.50  
*Classic region, classic sauvignon- A rich dryness with attractive, bone dry, lemony overtones*

- 41 Masson Blondele, Pouilly Fume, Loire 16.50  
*Delicious, everything that it ought to be.*

### Germany

- 42 Villa Wolf Pinot Gris, Pfalz 10.50  
*Pinot Grigio's porky big brother – touches of pineapple and stone fruits – great with fish and chicken*

### Italy

- 44 Gavi, La Scolca, DOCG 14.00  
*A great entry level Gavi, there's a lot more to this little beauty than first meets the eye, it's subtle and delightful*

### New Zealand

- 32 Sauvignon Blanc, Ara, Marlborough, New Zealand 9.50  
*Drink for breakfast, lunch or dinner...it's a treat*

- 45 Wild Rock "Infamous Goose" Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough 12.50  
*Lovely, lovely, lovely...a more refined Kivi Sauvignon is hard to find – Cloudy who?*

### Spain

- 46 Val Do Sosego, Albarino, Spain 13.50  
*Complex and elegant, yet simple and unassuming – dry and citrus flavours. Try it and love it. A Spanish sizzler!*
